Policy Statement

Although we do not have a formal school uniform we have a dress code that reflects our school philosophy and meets the criteria required to be a SunSmart school.

Definitions

Dress Code refers to the dress requirements of students

Implementation

- The Dress Code Policy applies during school hours
- Other specific regulations apply for PE lessons and lessons that take place in laboratories and workshops. For these lessons safety is paramount.
- Camps may have specific clothing requirements and information will be sent out prior to each camp.
- All hats must be Sunsmart hats consistent with our Sunsmart policy. Hats must be worn outside from 1 September through to 30 April. Hats are not to be worn inside.

Evaluation and review

- Minor review conducted annually.
- Major review on a recurrent basis as deemed necessary by Principal and School Board.
